- Washing or rinsing any motor vehicles or pleasure craft whatsoever including, but not limited to, cars, trucks, RV's, boats, motorcycles, jet skis, etc., is prohibited and subject to a penalty of \$25 after one warning.

The motion, seconded by Charlene Gabriel, carried.

Owner Request for Garage Door Credit: Following review of the criteria that damage to the exterior surface of the wooden garage doors for which the Association is responsible is a requirement for the Board to grant a credit to an owner towards the purchase of a roll-up garage door, Eric Beveridge called for a motion to grant the credit. There being no motion, the credit will not be granted.

Landscape Improvements: Drew Corley made a motion to accept the \$4,378 Sorrento Landscape proposal to continue the renovation design started at Unit 296 beginning with Unit 266 working down to Unit 243. The motion, seconded by James Tuck, carried.

S.D.G.&E. Easement Agreement: Barbara Orvik reported that the Agreement had not yet been received from S.D.G.&E.

The meeting was adjourned to Executive Session at 7:10 P.M. to discuss management services.
